This latest addition to the C&C fleet also features best-of-breed equipment and amenities from premium deck hardware and power systems, to an interior that would make a cruising boat envious.

Construction

The C&C 99 hull is vacuum-bagged, post-cured, wet-preg epoxy composite construction.

C & C added "E"-glass and Carbon reinforcements at high-stress areas for extra strength which produced a boat that is more seaworthy (lower center of gravity), lighter, stronger and stiffer hull that is ten times stronger than if the boat was built with far less expensive polyester resin.

All this produces an extremely stable, fast and robust sailboat that earned a Class CE-A rating for unlimited offshore racing or cruising.
